25 → 36	High Risk: Unacceptable, eliminate, use a relevant method to reduce risk to an acceptable level.
12 → 24	Medium Risk: Acceptable only with the full implementation of all of the control measures identified below
1 → 11	Low Risk: Reduce risk further where cost and time allows. Maintain all basic disciplines and control measures.
