











Guide Name	Setup and Configuration of a YubiKey

This guide describes the procedure for setting up and configuring a YubiKey, a physical security key used for two-factor authentication.

Steps	Description	Navigation
Download and Install	<p>Download and install “Yubico Authenticator.”</p> <p>Windows: https://developers.yubico.com/yubioath-flutter/Releases/yubico-authenticator-latest-win64.msi</p> <p>MAC: https://developers.yubico.com/yubioath-flutter/Releases/yubico-authenticator-latest-mac.dmg</p>	
Open the App and Configure YubiKey	Open the app and tap “Configure YubiKey.”	
	Tap “Add Account.”	
	Keep the “Add account” window open while completing the next steps.	
Log in to the Office Portal	Go to https://portal.office.com/ and sign in with your DTU account.	
	Click on your profile picture or initials in the upper-right corner.	
	Click “View Account.”	
	Click “Security Info” in the menu on the left.	
	Click “Add sign-in method.”	

	Select "Authenticator App" from the drop-down menu and click "Add."	
	Click "I want to use a different authenticator app."	
	Click "Next" and keep the next window with the QR code open.	
Add Account in Yubico Authenticator	<p>Return to the YubiKey app.</p> <p>Tap "Scan QR code."</p> <p>All required fields will be filled in automatically. Tap "Save" in the upper-right corner of the Yubico app.</p> <p>Your Yubico app is now configured with a 6-digit code on a 30-second timer.</p>	
Verify Configuration	<p>Enter the 6-digit code from the Yubico app.</p> <p>Click "Next."</p>	
Finish Setup	The setup is complete. Your PC is now installed and configured to use a YubiKey for multi-factor authentication.	
	<p>Remove your YubiKey from your PC.</p> <p>Note that the Yubico app will ask you to insert your key before you can view temporary codes.</p>
