







This guide describes how to install a printer from DTU's network if you are working on an Ubuntu operating system.

Steps	Description	Navigation
<p>Open Printer Settings</p>	<p>Open 'System Settings' and select 'Printers'</p>	
<p>Add New Printer</p>	<p>Press "Add" to add a new printer.</p>	
<p>Select Printer Type</p>	<p>Choose "Network Printer" and then "Windows Printer via SAMBA"</p> <p>In the right section, add the printer using the printer's address. Enter the printer's address in the field under smb:// e.g., ait-print.win.dtu.dk/LY305-101A-CO1</p>	
	<p>If you run into any additional software under the installation, simply accept them and proceed</p>	
<p>Select Printer Driver</p>	<p>Find the printer's brand and model, usually it will be on the top, front, or side of the printer. In this case, the printer is a KONICA MINOLTA C554, so we select the driver for the C550 series.</p>	
<p>Name and Locate the Printer</p>	<p>Pick a name and location for the printer, so that you can identify it</p>	
<p>Test</p>	<p>When you print a test page, you will be greeted with a login box. Use your DTU login</p>
