



Calling E-election with term of office starting on 1 January 2027

In accordance with the Statutes of the Technical University of Denmark, and pursuant to the applicable election rules approved by the Election Board set up by the President of the university, elections are hereby called for:

The following positions are open for elections this year:

- Academic Council: 3 students for 1 year and eight scientific staff for 3 years.
- DTU's Board of Governors: 1 student for 2 years.
- Departmental Study Committees: students for 1 year and scientific staff for 3 years.
- Ph.D. Committee: Ph.D. students for 1 year and scientific staff for 3 years.
- Interdisciplinary Education Committees (CUU and DUU): students for 1 year and scientific staff for 3 years (held in January).

Note: Ph.D. students in election group 1 can also run as Scientific staff for the Academic Council, Departmental Study Boards, and Interdisciplinary Education Committees.

If you want to run as a candidate, you can register online from 19 October until 2 November 2026. Voting will take place electronically from 17 November until 19 November 2026. The results of the elections are posted 23 November on Inside and student.dtu.dk.

Terms and conditions for participation in election

To be eligible to participate in the election process, employees must have been employed no later than 30 September 2026. Students must be enrolled by 30 September, 2026. You must be employed (in the same election group) or be a student at the time of the election.

Students from the entry course and students following part-time programmes (open education) are neither eligible for election nor entitled to vote.

Governing bodies

Elections to the governing bodies are held as proportional representation elections between lists, with the option of establishing list and electoral pacts.

DTU's Board of Governors

1 member is elected for 2 years (until the end of 2028) by and among the students (election group IIIa and IIIb).

Academic Council

3 members are elected for one year (until the end of 2027) by and among the students (election group IIIa and IIIb).

8 members of the scientific staff will be elected for 3 years (until the end of 2029) from among and by the scientific personnel (election group I).

Departmental Study Committees

Half the members are to be elected for one year (until the end of 2027) by and from among the students (election group IIIa and IIIb). The students are only eligible to stand for election and vote at one and the same department (the department to which the student is affiliated in the DTUbasen)

The other half of the members will be elected for 3 years (until the end of 2029) from among and by the scientific personnel (election group I) employed at the department.

Half the members of each PhD Committee are students who are elected for one year (until the end of 2027) by and from among PhD students (election group I and IIIc).

Half the members of each PhD Committee are scientific staff to be elected for 3 years (until the end of 2029) by and among the senior scientific staff who supervise PhDs i.e. professors, associate professors, senior scientists and senior advisors (election group I).

Interdisciplinary Education Committees (BSc and BEng)

3 members are elected for 1 year to each of the two Interdisciplinary Education Committees by and among the students. The students who can be elected must be members of a departmental study board or have previously been members of a study board.

3 members shall be elected for a three-year term by and from among the Heads of Studies.

3 members shall be elected for a three-year term by and from among the Chairs of the Boards of Studies.
